**Graduation Information**

The graduation rate is calculated by dividing the number of graduates by the number of ninth graders four years earlier. The ninth grade enrollment reflects the number of new students entering the district, the number moving out, and the number failing over the four-year period.

On January 8, 2002, President Bush signed into law the No Child Left Behind Act of 2001. This law requires that schools provide parents with a report card on student performance at their child's school as well as for the District. In efforts to describe the performance of the students in our school, we are providing you with a snapshot of their academic performance on the Subject Area Testing Program (SATP). Also, a three-year trend of SATP results is provided.

Further, the professional qualifications of teachers in the core academic subject areas of English, reading, language arts, science, mathematics, foreign languages, civics and government, arts, history and geography are included. Highly-qualified teachers are those who held state certification during the 2005-2006 school year.

**Teacher Quality**

99.5% of the 25 No Child Left Behind core academic subject teachers based on full time equivalents was highly qualified

99.3% of the 149 No Child Left Behind core academic classes were taught by a highly qualified teacher

The 2007-08 test participation rates are calculated separately for reading/language arts and mathematics. They are based on students enrolled in grades 7- 12, students with disabilities coded as ungraded who were the same age as students in those grades and students enrolled in English II or Algebra I during the school year. All students who took an MCT at grade level, and alternate assessment, and English II test, or an Algebra 1 Test were counted as tested
